Great Fast – Fasting and Abstinence Regulation for 2020. Fast and abstinence from meat and dairy products: 1. First Monday of the Great Fast (Lent), February 24. 2. Good Friday April 10. Fast from meat: 1. All Fridays of the Great Fast. 2. Holy Saturday April 11; Wednesdays of the Great Fast are recommended but not obligatory. Mon, Tues, Wed and Thurs of Holy Week are customary but not obligatory. This is obligatory for those between the ages of 14 and 59.
