Life for Arsen - conquering SMA. Life is the cost of one injection Goal: \$2 300 000 Raised:

\$ 1 123 000 . Arsen, who was diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA), was born on October 9, 2019 in Skalat, Ternopil region, Ukraine. SMA has been called the number one killer of hereditary diseases. It is a genetic condition that causes muscle weakness and atrophy (when muscles get smaller). SMA can affect a child's ability to crawl, walk, sit up, and control head movements. Severe SMA can damage the muscles used for breathing and swallowing. There is no treatment available in Ukraine. Next Sunday, June 6, 2021 we will have a special collection to help Arsen.
