Holyday of Obligation – Today, August 15th is the **Dormition (Assumption) of our Most Holy Mother of God and Ever Virgin Mary**. As is our custom, we will have the traditional blessing of flowers, plants, and herbs. Mirovania (Anointing with Holy Oil) after the Divine Liturgy.

Holy Tradition tells us that all the Apostles, except Holy and Glorious Apostle Thomas, were able to be in Jerusalem in order to be with The Theotokos as she died and to be present at her burial. When the Apostle Thomas arrived the next day, they opened the tomb so that he could say his farewell. They found only an empty tomb filled with sweet-smelling flowers. We bless flowers and aromatic herbs in remembrance of this great sign of her holiness.
