**Holyday of Obligation** – Sunday, August 15<sup>th</sup> is the **Dormition (Assumption) of our Most Holy Mother of God and Ever Virgin Mary**. The Divine Liturgy will be celebrated at 9:30 AM. As is our custom, we will have the traditional blessing of flowers, plants, and herbs. Mirovania (Anointing with Holy Oil) after the Divine Liturgy.

**Dormition Fast** – beginning Aug 1<sup>st</sup> through Aug 14<sup>th</sup>. Abstinence from meat on Wednesdays and Fridays.

**Mirovania** – The anointing with Holy Oil taking place at the end of a solemn Holy Day Liturgy. The faithful approach to venerate the icon of the feast, displayed on the tetrapod. The priest anoints the faithful with holy oil and says “**Christ is among us!**” The faithful respond “**He is and will be!**” The antidoran is distributed after the anointing.
