Church Year begins September 1st : In the Eastern Catholic Churches, the new Church Year starts on September 1st (Gregorian Calendar); September 14th on the Julian Calendar. According to the Gregorian calendar, the church year is from September 1st to August 31st. At the Ecumenical Council of Nicaea held in 325, the Church Fathers accepted this date, (September 1st) as the official beginning of the church year. The role of the Mother of God in salvation history is integral and two of Her feasts are given a predominate place: one at the beginning, Feast of the Nativity of the Mother of God (September 8th) and another at the end of the church year, Feast of the Dormition (August 15th).
