In just 5 days, 5,000 families have signed up on Welcome Connect, hoping to connect with potential sponsors as they seek refuge in the United States. Welcome Connect is a first-of-its-kind platform that enables Americans who want to be a sponsor, but don’t know anyone fleeing the war in Ukraine, to be connected with Ukrainians seeking refuge.

We have been contacted by [Welcome.US](https://www.welcome.us) with an ask to try to find people to sign up to be sponsors. Welcome has created a platform where Ukrainians can sign up to find a sponsor and for individuals who want to be sponsors to sign up to find beneficiaries. They’ve had over 5,000 Ukrainian families sign up looking for sponsors in 5 days. There is currently a shortage of sponsors. If you could please share the below information with your parishes and communities. There’s a webinar this afternoon – which I know most will not be able to attend given the very late notice.
