During February-May 2022, thanks to the generous support of the Humanitarian Aid Fund of the Ukrainian Catholic Metropolia of Philadelphia, the Ukrainian Catholic University provided assistance to people who are suffering from the war in Ukraine in the amount of \$1,484,779.00. Of this amount, 78% was spent on medical needs, 21% on food purchases, and the remaining funds were spent on logistics and other expenses related to the provision of humanitarian aid.

Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek-Catholic Church was held in Przemyshl, Poland from July 7-15, 2022. Metropolitan Borys Gudziak and Auxiliary Bishop Andriy Rabiy along with more than 40 Ukrainian Greek-Catholic Bishops from Ukraine and other countries participated in the Synod, presided by His Beatitude Sviatoslav Shevchuk.
