**The Feast of Pentecost Today** – at the beginning of the Divine Liturgy we kneel for the prayer, “Heavenly King.” After the Liturgy, the Kneeling Prayers of Pentecost are recited. Afterwards Mirovannia (Anointing of the Holy oil) and the distribution of the Blessed Prospora Bread.

**Prayer to the Holy Spirit at the beginning of the Divine Liturgy** “Heavenly King, Advocate, Spirit of Truth, Who are present everywhere and fill all things, Treasury of Blessings, Bestower of Life, come and dwell within us, cleanse us of all that defiles us, and, O Good One, save our souls.”

**Monday, June 6<sup>th</sup> is a Feast Day** – the Commemoration of the Holy Spirit. Divine Liturgy will be celebrated at 9:00 AM. All of Pentecost week, from June 5 – 11 is free from fast & abstinence.
