Christmas to Theophany, December 25th to January 4th is Free from Fast and Abstinence.

During the celebration of Christmas, it is the custom of Christians to greet one another with the joyous exclamation, "Christ is born!" to which the one greeted responds, "Glorify Him!" or in Ukrainian "Христос рождається! Славімо Його!"

Wednesday, January 1st is the Feast of Circumcision of Our Lord, St. Basil the Great - Archbishop. The Divine Liturgy will be celebrated at 10:00 AM. There will be anointing with holy oil and distribution of the blessed bread.

Sunday, January 5th is the Eve of the Theophany (Schedryi Vechir). The strict abstinence from meat or dairy products may be observed voluntarily.
