On Saturday, November 22, **St. Patrick’s Cathedral in New York City** hosted the Ukrainian community for the annual commemoration of the **92nd Anniversary of the Holodomor**—the Famine-Genocide of 1932–33. Organized by the Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA), the gathering brought together clergy, diplomats, community leaders, parishioners, and many children who joined the remembrance. A Panakhyda memorial service followed, with responses sung by the Ukrainian DUMKA Choir under Professor Wasyl Hryczynsky, giving the liturgical portion of the commemoration its solemn and prayerful atmosphere.
