Great Fast – Fasting and Abstinence Regulation for 2026. Fast and abstinence from meat and dairy products: 1. First Monday of the Great Fast (Lent), February 16th. 2. Good Friday April 3rd. Fast from meat: 1. All Fridays of the Great Fast. 2. Holy Saturday April 4th; Wednesdays of the Great Fast are recommended but not obligatory. Mon, Tues, Wed and Thurs of Holy Week are customary but not obligatory. This is obligatory for those between the ages of 14 and 59.

The Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts will be celebrated on Wednesdays in Ukrainian and Fridays in English at 7:00 PM.

Sorokousty Memorial Services: We honor the memory of our beloved deceased with Sorokousty Memorial Services on all Saturdays of Lent. Please use your Sorokousty envelope or write the names on a piece of paper and place it in an envelope and place it in the collection basket. Please put your name or your family name on the envelope.
